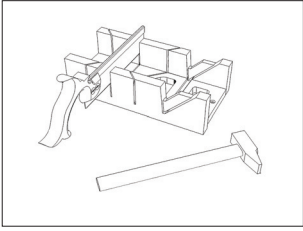




CONCEPT BOIS MURAL VERTICAL FITTING

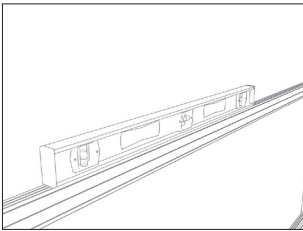
Concept Bois Mural can also be installed using traditional brackets.

STEP 1 :



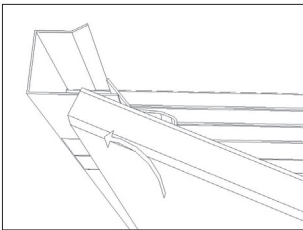
- 1• You will need...**
- Hammer and wooden tapping block
 - Handsaw or chop saw
 - Spirit level
 - Starter clips
 - Mounting clips
 - Methylated spirits and rag
 - Woodstain
 - Polymer glue.

STEP 3 :



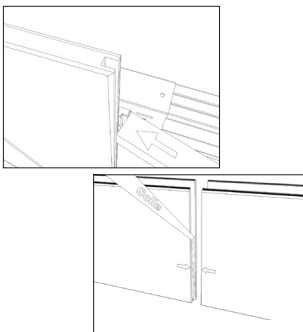
- 3• Prepare the metal frame.**
- Once this is in place, use a spirit level to check that it is flat and the metal rails are aligned.
 - Make sure the centre-to-centre distance of the horizontal rails does not exceed 60 centimetres.

STEP 5 :



- 5• Attach the starter clips of the first strip to the left-hand fixing rail, using a tapping block to keep the cladding off the floor.**

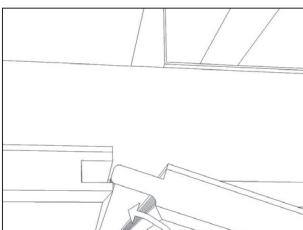
STEP 7 :



- 7• Use the tapping block to push the mounting clips into the groove and lock the strip in place.**

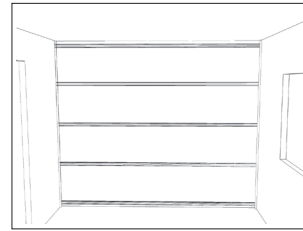
Repeat the last two steps for the rest of the row, add a small amount of glue on each plank tongue widthwise.

STEP 9 :



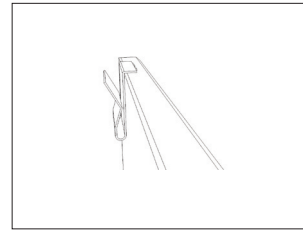
- 9• Fit the last strip.**
- Measure the distance from the penultimate strip and the finished floor and cut one centimetre off this to create an expansion joint.
 - Cut the last strip lengthwise to the required width.
 - Wipe any grease off the rails with the methylated spirits.
 - Place a dot of glue on each rail.
 - Fit the last strip and hold in place for a few moments.

STEP 2 :



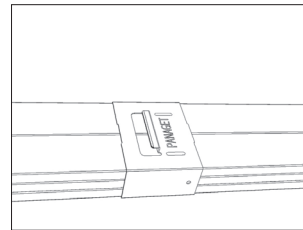
- 2• Make sure your frame is ready and any cable ducts and insulation are in position.**

STEP 4 :



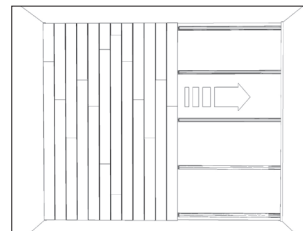
- 4• Fix the first strip in place, starting from the top.**
- Saw the tongue off the first strip.
 - Pin the starter clips to the cut section of the strip.

STEP 6 :



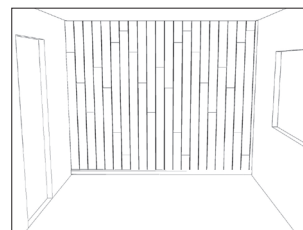
- 6• Place a row of Panaget mounting clips on each metal rail to the right of the strip.** N.B The rail sizes may vary depending on the type used. You will therefore need to tighten the clips or use a self-tapping screw.

STEP 8 :



- 8• Install the following rows.**
- Start each row with the off-cut of the previous one. This should be longer than twice the width of the strip, for aesthetic reasons.
 - Fit each strip into the previous one.
 - Install the mounting clips as for the first strip.
 - Repeat until you reach the bottom of the wall.

STEP 10 :



- 10• Add the finishing accessories.**
- Stain the corner beading and other unfinished surfaces.
 - Fit the beading and skirting.
